

HTH Bachelor Programme overview

To help you navigate the curriculum please see the below:

A block refers to a 10 week teaching session – there are usually 4 blocks within an academic phase (or academic year).

EC refers to European Credits, or ECTS. The bachelor programme at HTH consists of a 240 EC programme. We offer a 4 year programme (4 x 60 EC) You can see under each module how many credits it carries.

MO = Managing an Outlet. You will gain experience of managing a hospitality outlet in one of our on campus facilities.

Exchange option: Hotelschool The Hague has fantastic exchange opportunities at our world leading academic partner universities. You will learn more about these in your academic induction.

Outdoor: In Year 2 every student takes part in Outdoor, which is an intensive team building and leadership mini-course in Belgium. You will learn more about this at academic induction.

LYCar = Launching Your Career is the final part of your Bachelor in Hospitality Management and is composed of both an industry placement and final thesis.
